Professor Robert Simmons FRS is an expert on the biophysics of animal muscles who started his training under Andrew Huxley, with whom he developed methods of measuring muscle mechanics. His technical achievements set new standards in experimentation, which in application have had a broad impact on muscle research.

Geoff Read has had a long career as consulting civil engineer with the World Bank and has regularly been called upon to advise on emergencies such as earthquakes and tsunamis particularly in Asia. He is a director of INTO the international Trust of National Trusts and is currently involved with conservation of the Rain Forests of Indonesia.

Dr Nick Maurice OBE is best known for his charitable work in the Gambia, where he developed what is now a 30+ year partnership between a Muslim fishing village and Marlborough in Wiltshire under the aegis of the Marlborough Brandt Group. A constant programme of exchange and development has seen numerous young English students visit, assist with local projects, and learn from the people of Gunjur.
